



Town of Palm Beach Marina Project Update

(Summer 2019)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does the project entail?

- Planned for 84 floating dock slips ranging from 65' to 294' with improved wave attenuation.
- Upgraded electric service with enhanced Wifi, sanitary, potable water, fire suppression, security, and trash collection.
- New Brazilian, Peruvian, and Australian dock buildings.
- An upgraded bulkhead.

When will the project begin and when will it be completed? Anticipated start date is May 2020 with 15 months to completion.

Will the project remain open during the construction? No, but as work progresses soft openings may occur.

When will the new rates be determined? Town Council will approve rates corresponding with the market.

Do current leases have the first option to secure a space? Yes

Will there be slips for smaller boats? Yes

Will the shore power be increased? Yes, single and three phase power will be available at the majority of slips. The Australian dock will have 208 and 480V three phase power.
