DIVISION 1. GENERALLY

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Sec. 94-151. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this division, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Garage sale means any sale or offering for sale of personal property by a member of a family or other household unit, such personal property having been acquired, possessed and used by the family or household for personal as opposed to business or commercial use, when such sale is to be or is conducted at the present residence of such family or household. The term "garage sale" shall include sales commonly referred to as patio sales, driveway sales, yard sales and other such sales. The term "garage sales" shall not include the sale or offering for sale of any goods on consignment, nor shall it include the sale or offering for sale of goods of more than one family or household.

No garage sale may be conducted within the town without a permit having been first issued for such sale by the director of finance.

Sec. 94-177. Written statement required.

Prior to issuance of any garage sale permit, the person conducting such sale shall file a written statement with the director of finance setting forth the following information:

- (1) The person's interest in the residential property, such as ownership, current lessee or such other control as the person may have;
- (2) Ownership of the property to be sold;
- (3) Purposes for which the property to be sold has been previously used; and
- (4) Affirmative statement that the property to be sold was neither acquired nor consigned for the purposes of resale.

Sec. 94-178. Fee.

There shall be an administrative processing fee in an amount determined by resolution of the town council, as may be amended from time to time, for the issuance of a garage sale permit.

Sec. 94-179. Only one permit per year allowed.

No more than one garage sale permit shall be issued to one residence, family or household during any calendar year.

Sec. 94-180. Permit to limit time and place.

The permit for a garage sale shall limit the time and location of such sale.

Sec. 94-181. Sale restricted to daylight, three days.

A garage sale permit shall be limited in time to no more than the daylight hours of three consecutive days.

Sec. 94-182. Display of permit.

The permit required by this article shall be prominently displayed at a garage sale.

Sec. 94-183. Display of property for sale.

No property offered for sale or sold at a garage sale shall be displayed outside the permanent structures of the residence, including houses, garages and carports, except such property as might normally be located in the town or yard (i.e., lawn furniture, swing sets, lawn mowers, etc.).

Sec. 94-184. One sign permitted.

One sign of not more than four square feet shall be permitted to be displayed on the property of the residence where a garage sale is being conducted pursuant to a permit issued under this article. Such sign shall be displayed only during the times of the sales as delineated on the permit. In no case shall the sign be placed on the public right-of-way or on any property other than the property of the residence to which the permit has been issued.

Sec. 94-185. Parking.

All parking of vehicles at garage sales shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable laws and ordinances. Further, the police department may enforce such temporary controls that would alleviate any special hazards or congestion created by any garage sale.

Sec. 94-186. Compliance with other regulations.

Garage sales shall be conducted in compliance with all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations not in conflict herewith.
