Class I and Class II wildlife as designated by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission or its successor organization as designated by the State of Florida may be allowed on all Town owned property and all private property located within a commercial, R-D(1), R-D(2) and PUD-A zoning district provided all permit requirements have been met and a minimum setback buffer of not less than fifty (50) feet is maintained between the location of the wildlife and the nearest adjacent residentially zoned areas of the Town.
