Construction and Traffic Highlights for the Week of 6/26/2017

- (1) **FLAGLER MEMORIAL BRIDGE:** Construction continues on the Flagler Memorial Bridge. - (2) **FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT (Flagler Bridge):** Florida Power and Light will be closing the southbound right turn lane on Bradley Place between Royal Poinciana Way and Sunset Avenue from 8am to 6pm. One lane of traffic southbound on Bradley Place will be maintained throughout the duration of construction.
- (3) **SOUTHERN BOULEVARD BRIDGE:** Construction has started on the Southern Boulevard Bridge. - (4) **STREET LIGHT REPLACEMENT-TOWNWIDE:** The Town's street light contractor will be working on streetlights on North County Road from Wells Road to Royal Poinciana Way and on Coconut Row from Royal Poinciana Way to Chapel Hill Road. Two lanes of Traffic will be maintained. Peruvian Avenue between Coconut Row and South County Road. The contractor will maintain one lane of traffic and access to residence driveways. The contractor will also be on South County (Royal Palm Way to Worth Avenue) and Bradley Place (Seminole Avenue to Sunset Avenue) for directional drilling. Two lanes of Traffic will be maintained.
- (5) **LAKE TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS:** Milling and resurfacing work will be conducted at the following locations. The path will be closed at these locations from May 30 to June 28.
 - Sunset Avenue to Dunbar Road
 - Esplanade Way to Palmo Way

In response to local residence request, the next phases have been modified to focus on completing the Lake Trail from the Country Club Road north. Therefore, once section from Sunset Avenue to Dunbar Road is completed the construction will transition to two crews working from Country Club Road to Palmo Way.

(6) NIGHTINGALE TRAIL AND LA PUERTA WAY UNDERGROUND UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS: The Town's contractor will be working on North Ocean Blvd. between Queens Lane and Nightingale Trail. During that time North Ocean Blvd. will be closed and traffic will be detoured to North Lake Way. Please follow the construction signage and drive carefully within that area. This work will be completed by the end of the day on Wednesday, June 28.

(7) FPU GAS LINE REPLACEMENTS: Installation of gas lines, gas service connections, and sidewalk and road restoration will take place on the following streets. Traffic will be directed by flaggers.

- Peruvian Ave between S. County Rd and S. Lake Dr
- Australian Ave between S. County Rd and S. Lake Dr
- Chilean Ave between S. County Rd and S. Lake Dr
- S. Lake Dr between Worth Ave and Chilean Ave
- 100 Block of Seaview Avenue

(8) HYPOWER INSTALLING FIBERNET TO BREAKERS: Western southbound lane on South County Road between the Breakers and Royal Palm Way will be closed at times for directional boring. HyPower will be finishing up the drilling on South County Road and begin drilling on Royal Palm Way with a temporary closure of the western southbound lane. Once the work on South County Road is completed, they will begin at the SW corner of Lake Drive South on Royal Palm Way and work east. The right lane in the eastbound traffic will be closed at times. Where possible the directional drilling will take place in the grass. The lane closure will have a work zone of approximately 450 feet and will be shifted.

(9) PUBLIC WORKS- On Thursday, June 29, 2017 between the hours of approximately 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM North Lake Way will be detoured between Nightingale Trail and Mockingbird Trail for design upgrades and routine maintenance of the Town's E-2 Sanitary Sewer Pumping Station. Vehicles traveling northbound will be diverted east on Nightingale Trail to South Ocean Boulevard. Vehicles traveling southbound on North Lake Way will be diverted east on Mockingbird Trail to South Ocean Boulevard.

RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMITS

Private construction projects are limited to 3 on-street parking permits. Surrounding residents should not be adversely impacted by construction vehicles and/or associated employee parking. Please call 561-838-5440 to report congestion or abuse.

A right of way permit has been issued to AT&T to work in the manholes on Bradley Place from Sunset Avenue to Park Avenue in the right of way. Traffic will be maintain with flaggers and signs.

A right of way permit has been issued to AT&T to work in the manholes on Cocoanut Row from Primavera Avenue to Australian Avenue in the right of way. Traffic will be maintain with flaggers and signs.

A right of way permit has been issued 738 South County Road to block a lane for tree trimming. Traffic will be maintain with flaggers and signs.

A right of way permit has been issued to 287 Pendleton Avenue for FPL to block a lane on Cocoanut Row to remove an abandoned pole in the right of way. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers and signs.

A right of way permit has been issued to Carpenter Electric to block a lane at 710 South County Road to replace a streetlight. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers and signs

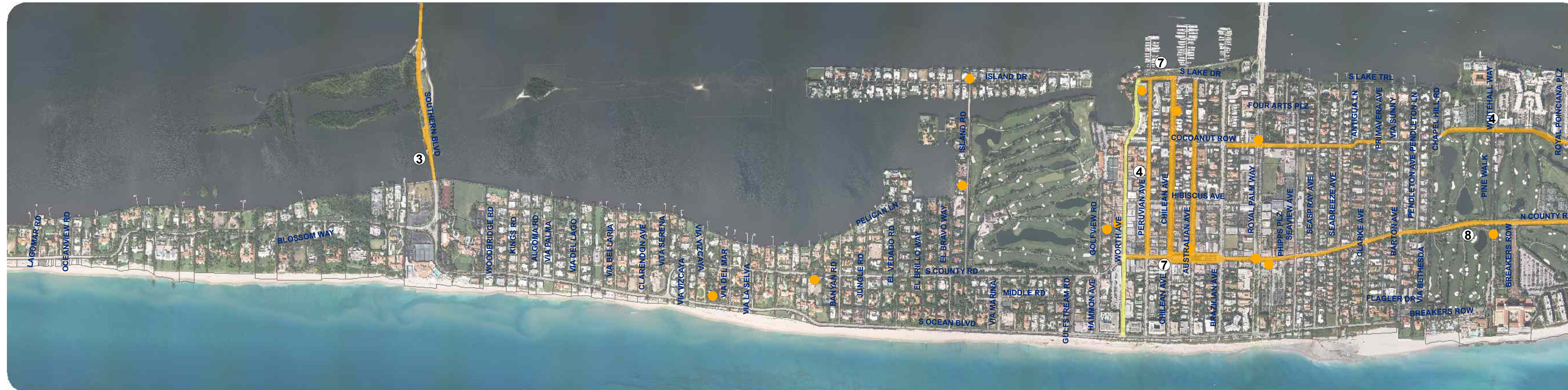
A right of way permit has been issued to Botanica Landscaping at 310 Island Road. A lane will be blocked to unload palm trees. Traffic will be directed with flaggers.

A ROW permit has been issued to Kasper Electric at Royal Palm Way and South County Road to replace street light pole in the median. The left turn lane will be blocked temporarily. Traffic will be directed with signs and flaggers.
