

SEC. 118-14 MARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

It is unlawful for any commercial vehicle to operate on the streets in the town without having the name of the owner displayed in a prominent place on each side of the vehicle in letters not less than two inches in height.

PARKING RIGHT-OF-WAY

- All equipment and vehicles must abide by all parking regulations posted on each street. Failure to do so will result in a parking ticket.
- Any violations of the right-of-way will result in a minimum fine of \$150 per day per vehicle for first offense, \$250 per day per vehicle for second offense and \$500 per day per vehicle thereafter. Violations include but are not limited to: working in the right-of-way without a permit, construction parking without a permit, inadequate maintenance of traffic, right-of-way littered by site dirt or debris, failure to maintain a safe sidewalk, storage of materials on right-of-way and/or use of right-of-way as a work area.

SEC. 26-2021
Hours for Landscaping

PEAK SEASON HOURS

The Monday preceding Thanksgiving thru April 30th

- No Landscaping on Saturdays, Sundays or legal holidays, including the Friday after Thanksgiving
- Landscaping allowed Monday—Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
- **NO lawn maintenance noise is permitted before 9 am**
- Workers are prohibited from arriving at sites prior to 7:30 am and are restricted from conducting any kind of site activity prior to 8 am during the week days.

ALL OTHER TIMES

- No Landscaping on Sundays or legal holidays. Landscaping is permitted the day after Thanksgiving.
- Landscaping allowed Monday—Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
- **NO lawn maintenance noise is permitted before 9 am**
- Landscaping—**quiet work only**—allowed Saturdays 9:00 am—5:00 pm
- Workers are prohibited from arriving at sites prior to 7:30 am and are restricted from conducting any kind of site activity prior to 8 am during the week days.
- Workers are prohibited from arriving at lawn maintenance sites prior to 8:30 am and are restricted from conducting any kind of site activity prior to 9 am on Saturdays, when limited work is permitted from may 1 through the Monday preceding Thanksgiving.

There shall be no commencement of large scale landscape installations at any time on Saturdays

SEC. 42-197 GASOLINE POWERED LEAF BLOWERS PROHIBITED

- Gasoline powered leaf blowers prohibited on any property which is less than one acre in size

SEC. 42-230 LAWN MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT NOISE

- Leaf blowers shall not exceed a decibel level of 65 dBA as measured at 50 ft from the point of operation
- It shall be unlawful to blow yard trash or clippings into a public street

SEC. 42-198 Operation of Certain Machinery during Winter, Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays—including the Friday after Thanksgiving

PEAK SEASON

The Monday preceding Thanksgiving thru April 30th

- The operation of the following machinery is **PROHIBITED**: dredges, hammer-driven pile drivers, gasoline, diesel or steam engines which emit offensive odors or noises, dry sandblasting machines, pneumatic jackhammers **AND** any other class of machinery or appliance that when used would render the enjoyment of the property less agreeable.
- **EXCEPTIONS**: It shall be within the discretion of the Town Council to grant permission for the use of prohibited machinery or appliances. Further, the operation of equipment relating to essential services of the Town and equipment operation during emergency conditions shall be exempt from these restrictions.

SEC. 102-45 CURBSIDE PLACEMENT AND COLLECTION OF TRASH

PEAK SEASON

November 1st thru April 30th (6 months)

- Yard trash may be placed on the public right-of-way adjacent to the property from which it came, not more than one (1) day prior to the scheduled day of collection.

OFF SEASON

May 1st thru October 31st (6 months)

- Yard trash may be placed on the public right-of-way adjacent to the property from which it came, not more than three (3) days prior to the scheduled day of collection.

- Placement of yard trash on state roads (AIA, SR 704, SR 80) is specifically prohibited. State roads are Royal Poinciana Way, Royal Palm Way, South County Road, Southern Blvd. and all of South Ocean Blvd. south of the intersection at S. County Road. You may use plastic barrels along the side of the street next to the property's trash pile.
 - The use of disposable containers such as plastic bags shall be prohibited from being placed in trash for collection.
 - Material being placed in the street for collection is restricted to yard vegetation resulting from trimming and pruning only.
 - Trash placed for collection shall not extend more than six (6) feet into the street from the curb or pavement edge and shall not obstruct the street or sidewalk or create an unsafe condition.
 - No item of trash placed for collection shall exceed eight (8) feet in length and six (6) inches in diameter.
 - Trash placed for collection shall be placed no closer than six (6) feet from any fire hydrant, utility pole, sign or street marker, trees with low overhanging branches, overhead cables or guy wires.
